### Fresh corn

Sad are the days in midfall when the last of sweet corn on the cob disappears from markets. But now kernel corn, fresh not frozen, is being offered year-round by Supreme Cuts as Off the Cob. We microwaved a bag of it for 3 minutes recently, drizzled it with olive oil and salt, dug into it and could have sworn it was mid-August. Handy to have for side dishes, soups, chowders or to liven up a green salad. With its 14-day shelf life, the corn comes triple washed and costs \$3.49 to \$3.99 for 12 ounces and can be found in the produce sections at King Kullen and other Long Island supermarkets.
